The Interpreter's Role is offered for 0.3 PS (professional studies) CEUs and assumes some knowledge of the topic. Participants must complete all required activities to earn CEUs. No partial CEUs will be awarded.

## Mental Health First Aid (MHFA):

*(Friday Evening & Saturday Morning)*

A public education program that introduces participants to risk factors and warning signs of mental illnesses, builds understanding of their impact, and overviews common supports. Uses role-playing and simulations to demonstrate how to offer initial help in a mental health crisis and connect persons to the appropriate professional, peer, social, and self-help care. Also teaches the common risk factors and warning signs of specific types of illnesses, like anxiety, depression, substance use, bipolar disorder, eating disorders, and schizophrenia. For this portion of the workshop, participants will earn 0.8 GS CEUs. Certified MHFA instructors provided through the Montgomery County ADAMHS Board.

**\*\*Participants will be certified in Mental Health First Aid for 3 years from the date of the workshop\*\***

## MHFA and The Interpreter's Role:

*(Friday Evening & All Day Saturday)*

After the 8-hour MHFA certification course, attendees will participate in a moderated discussion about how to maintain the integrity of the role of a professional interpreter, following the NAD-RID Code of Professional Conduct, while using the information learned from the ADAMHS MHFA instructors. For this portion of the workshop, participants will earn an additional 0.3 PS CEUs.

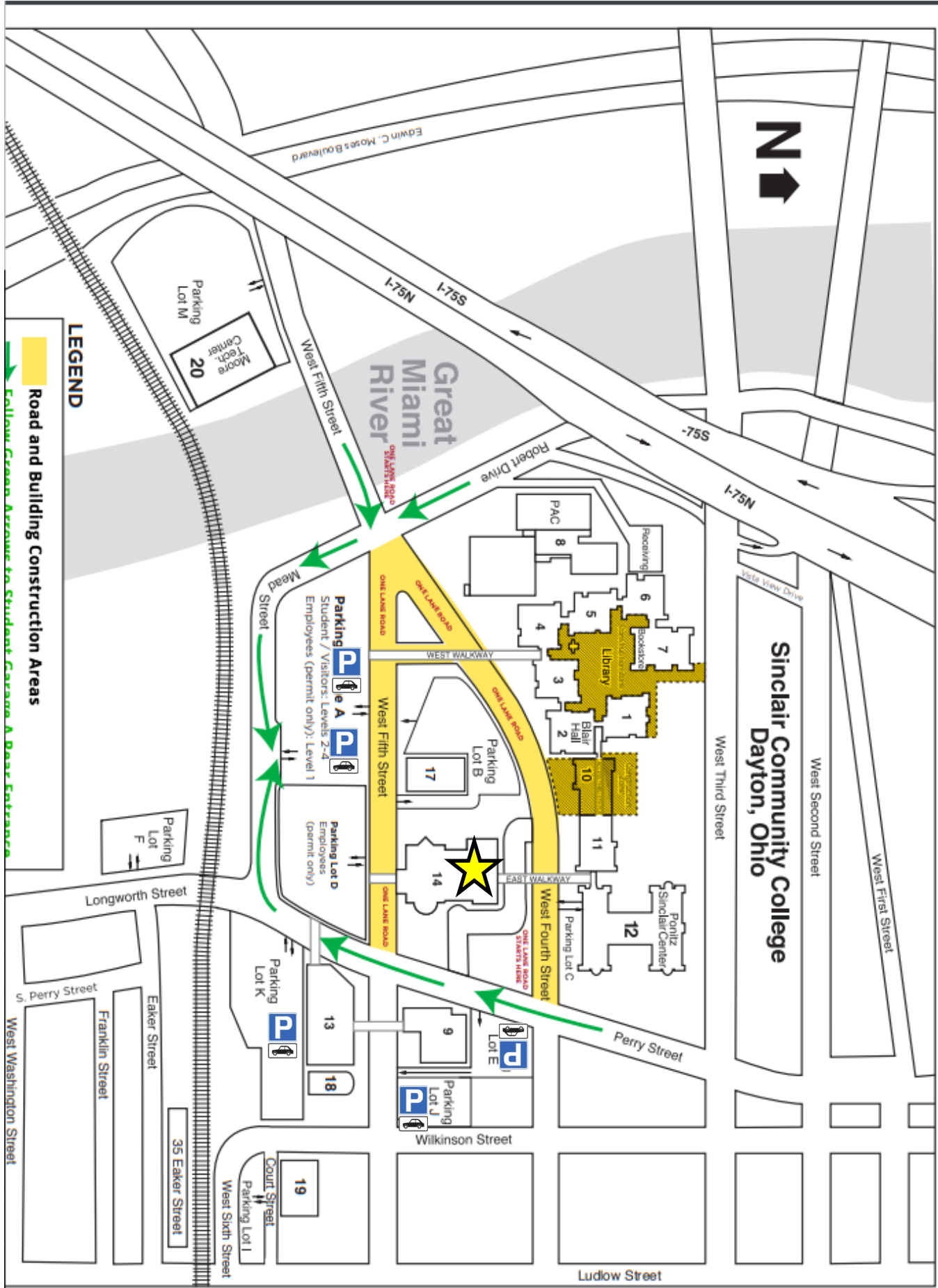
